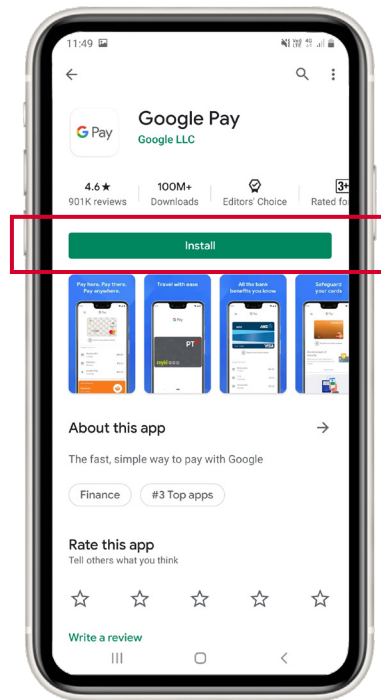

How to make a payment using Google Pay.

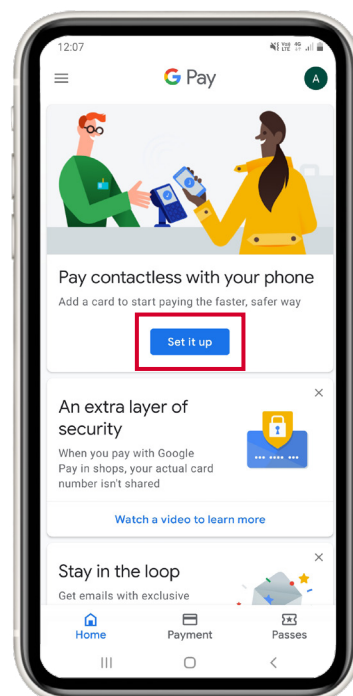
Step 1.

Download the 'Google Pay' app from the Google Play store.



Step 2.

Open the Google Pay app and follow the setup instructions.



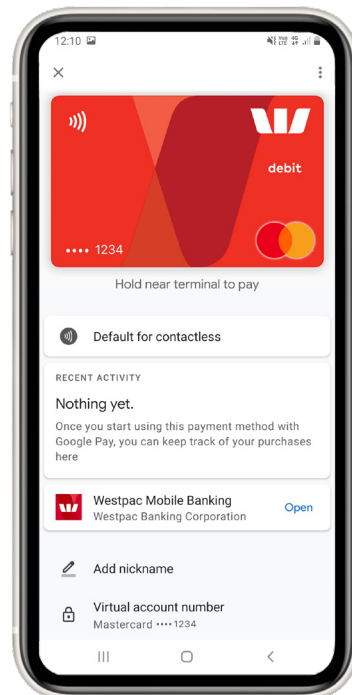
Step 3.

To make a payment, open Google Pay and tap the 'Payment' icon located on the bottom menu. Then select which card you want to pay with.



Step 4.

Hold your smartphone near the terminal to pay.
