



SEWF 2022 Rural Forum Bursary Fund - Terms and Conditions

1. Definitions

Applicant means a social enterprise which, by their representatives, applies to receive the SEWF Package by submitting an online application in accordance with these Terms and Conditions

Application means an application made by an Applicant to Westpac and White Box Enterprises for a Social Enterprise Business Boost Package

Panel has the meaning set out in clause 3.1

SEWF means the Social Enterprise World Forum (SEWF) Rural Forum to be held in Beechworth, Victoria, Australia, October 2022

SEWF 2019 Package means the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package package each Successful Applicant will be awarded in accordance with clause 3.2 herein

Successful Applicant means each Applicant who is awarded a Social Enterprise Business Boost Package

White Box Enterprises means White Box Enterprises Ltd (ABN 99 627 169 073)

Westpac means Westpac banking Corporation (ABN 33 007 457 141)

2. Applying for the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package

2.1 The Applicant must apply for the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package by completing an online application form at <https://sprw.io/stt-b78696> between 9am (AEST) on 15 November 2021 and 5pm (AEST) on 28 January 2022. Applications received outside of this time period will not be accepted. Only one Application per Applicant is permitted. As part of its Application, the Applicant must address all questions in the application form, and in particular, the following matters:

2.1.1 By applying for the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package, the Applicant warrants that its Application is the Applicant's original work and does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party, or contravene applicable laws;

2.1.2 If they are selected as a Successful Applicant:

2.1.2.1 they will redeem the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package for the sole purpose of attending and participating in the SEWF in accordance with clause 3.2 herein;

2.1.2.2 they will participate with an active social media presence during SEWF Rural Forum 2022 – at least daily posts on their social media channels, contribution to any onsite Australia social media presence

2.1.2.3 they will share learnings post SEWF Rural Forum 2022 with their networks, broader social enterprise sector and philanthropy in an agreed manner (such as participation in the capacity building support).

3. Selection of Successful Applicants

- 3.1 Successful Applicants will be selected by a panel of representatives from Westpac and White Box Enterprises. ("the Panel") in its sole discretion by weighting the scores of each Applicant's responses to the matters set out in the online application form and in clause 2 herein.
- 3.2 Each Successful Applicant will receive a Social Enterprise Business Boost package which includes attending the Social Enterprise World (Rural) Forum and accessing a package of capacity building support together valued at \$5,000. Specifically, the package includes:
 - 3.2.1 1 x ticket to the 3-day SEWF Rural Forum hosted by the Australian Centre for Rural Entrepreneurship in Beechworth Victoria including accommodation and \$500 funding towards travel (first week of Oct 2022);
 - 3.2.2 1 x digital ticket to the Social Enterprise World Forum 2022 being held in Brisbane (27 to 29 September 2022);
 - 3.2.3 2 x 1 hour Westpac Davidson Institute financial education sessions for guidance on money matters including maximising profits, saving or cashflow to be redeemed by March 2023;
 - 3.2.4 1 x 4 month virtual Group Leadership Program with Westpac Foundation to be redeemed by March 2023;
 - 3.2.5 1 x Resilience workshop and online wellbeing course by the Black Dog Institute Foundation to be redeemed by March 2023;
- 3.3 Of the inclusions detailed in clause 3.2 only \$500 will be paid to a nominated bank account for the Successful Applicant to cover the costs of travel to the SEWF Rural Forum.
- 3.4 Each Successful Applicant will be required to sign an agreement with Westpac confirming that these funds will be used solely for the purposes of attending the SEWF Rural Forum 2022
 - 3.4.1 For the avoidance of all doubt, the Applicant will be solely liable and responsible to fund the total cost of the travel to the extent it exceeds AUD\$500 and any fees or amounts incurred due to alteration or cancellation of the booking.
- 3.5 Westpac reserves the right to alter the nature and or inclusions of the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package without prior notice.
- 3.6 For the avoidance of all doubt, only 1 Social Enterprise Business Boost Package may be redeemed per Successful Applicant, and the bursary is non-transferable.
- 3.7 The Panel's selection of the Successful Applicants is final and binding on every Applicant and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 3.8 The Successful Applicants will be announced the day of the Social Enterprise World Forum launch (March 8th) and notified by Westpac by email during March 2022.

4. Privacy

- 4.1 4.1 All personal information, collected in relation to the Applicant as part of the Application is collected for the following purposes:
 - 4.1.1 to enable selection of the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package Recipients;
 - 4.1.2 to facilitate the redemption of the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package for each Successful Applicant;
 - 4.1.3 for future marketing and promotional purposes of Westpac;
 - 4.1.4 for research purposes;

4.1.5 for supply to any individuals or organisations who have contributed to the funding of the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package, or who have otherwise collaborated with Westpac in relation to the SEWF; and by submitting an entry, Applicants consent to the use of all information provided for the above purposes;

4.2 Otherwise, personal information will be collected and used in accordance with Westpac's Website Privacy Policy located at <https://www.westpac.com.au/privacy/privacy-policy/>. By applying for the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package the Applicant acknowledges that it has read the Privacy Policy.

5. Licence

5.1 By applying for the Social Enterprise Business Boost Package, the Applicant agrees to grant Westpac a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide license to republish the whole or any part of its Application for purposes connected with the SEWF.

6. Dispute Resolution

6.1 Where a dispute arises between Westpac and the Applicant in relation to these Terms and Conditions, the parties must not initiate legal proceedings against each other unless the following procedure has been followed:

6.1.1 the party claiming there is a dispute must send the other party a notice in writing setting out the nature of the dispute;

6.1.2 the parties must take all reasonable steps to resolve the dispute by negotiation and or mediation within 30 days of receipt of the written notice.

7. Limitation of Liability

7.1 Westpac is not liable for any damage, loss, liability, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by an Applicant as a result of applying for or being awarded a Social Enterprise Business Boost Package, including any loss incurred by a Successful Applicant in attending the SEWF.

8. Indemnity

8.1 The Applicant must indemnify Westpac against all liabilities, costs, expenses, damages or losses incurred by Westpac in relation to the Application, including for any third-party copyright or intellectual property rights infringed by the Application.

9. Governing Law

9.1 These terms and conditions are governed by, and are to be construed in accordance with, the laws of Queensland, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland.
