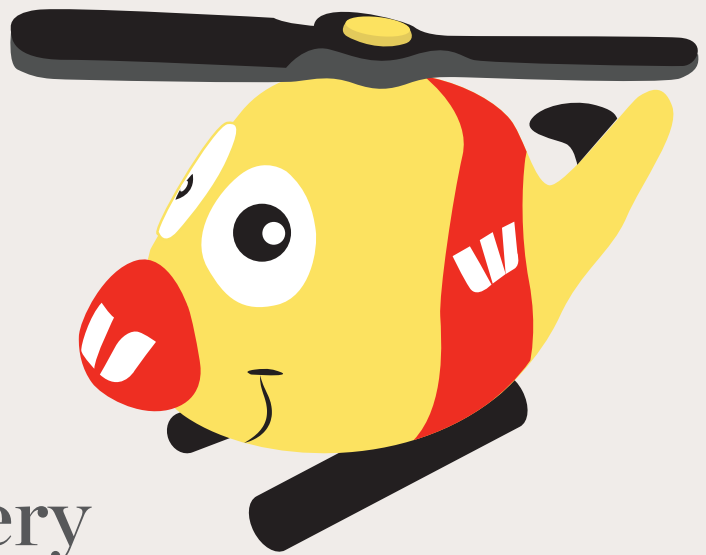

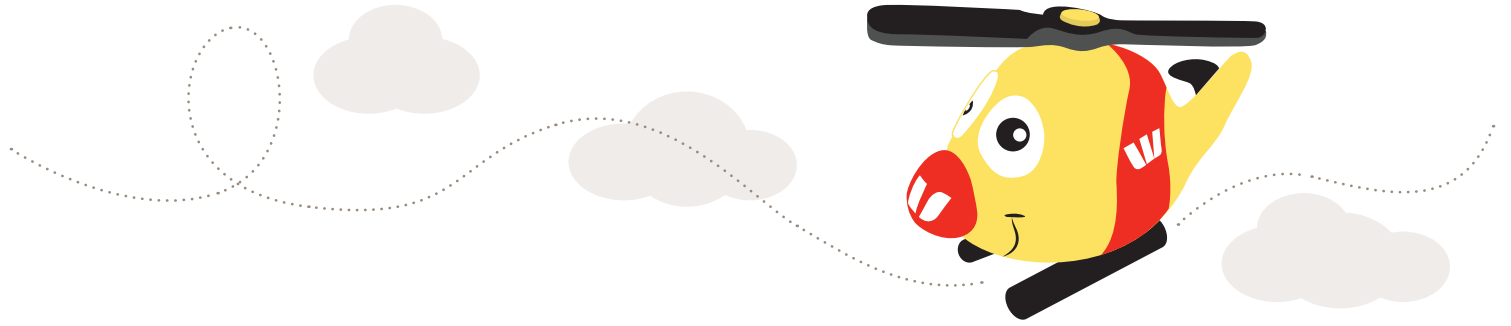

TASK ONE:

When you have finished watching video episode 4, 'The Mission', discuss and answer the questions below as a class.

RESCUE ONE: ESKY RESCUE

After the two fishermen are safe in the helicopter, the crew give them blankets to wear.

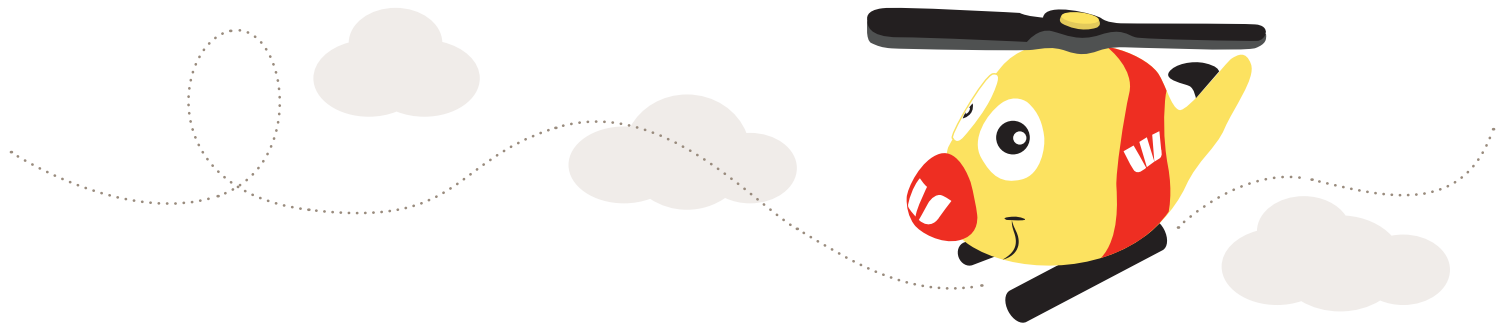
2. Talk about why they needed blankets. Why must humans stay warm to survive?

Like the Rescue Crew Officer from the Westpac Lifesaver Rescue Helicopter Service, you wear different clothes for different reasons and in different places.

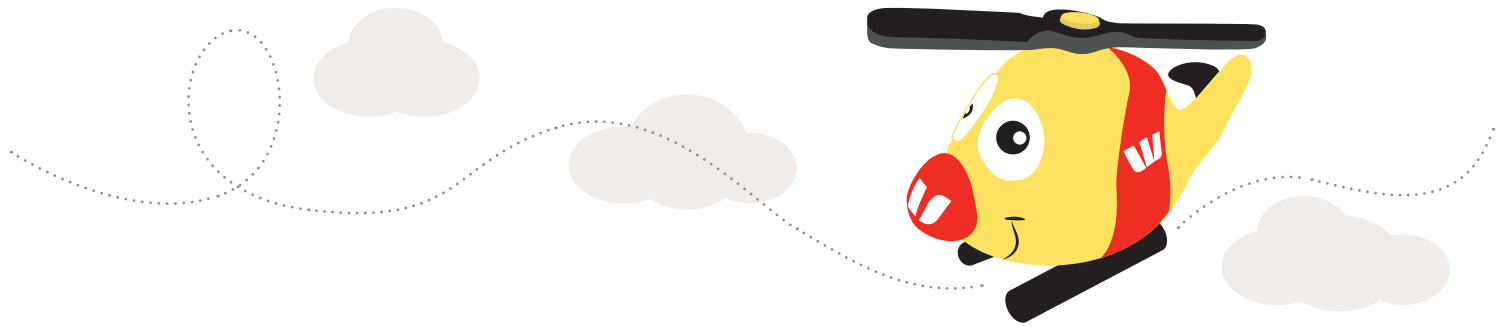
Below there are activities where you would wear different clothes. Practise your writing skills and trace over the dotted lines to read the words.
